



The Police and Fire Station provides a pleasant architectural image, consistent with that image of the town.

The facility is divided into three major areas: Police Department, Fire Department, and shared functions and/or areas.

The shared functions/areas include: public entry and waiting, training, dispatch, female locker facilities for both police and fire, general storage, and facility maintenance.

Police spaces include work areas including the Chief's office and officer workstations, law enforcement support spaces including a muster/meeting/ break room, male locker and restroom, law enforcement records, lab/evidence processing, evidence lockers, and one interview room. The booking area has a vehicle sallyport, booking desk, and two holding cells.



The Fire spaces include administration offices, apparatus bays, maintenance and storage, living quarters that includes a dorm with lockers, dayroom, kitchen, dining room, and male showers.
